As we celebrate **15 years of "Colours of Life"**, I would like to take this opportunity to share with you some memories of the artists who accompanied us on our journey in 2005 but are no longer with us today. Looking back I am amazed at our temerity. We were so raw that we ended up printing our catalogue with the cover inside out!

It was only the support and confidence of these titans in the field of art that made it possible for us to take our first hesitant steps in reaching our goal of earning enough money to support the treatment of a much larger number of children.



Badri Narayan (1929–2013)

When we called him in 2005, Badri Narayan readily agreed to give us his work. We never actually met him but received his work from that other legend of the art field, Kekoo Gandhi.



Datta Bansode (1969–2017)

Datta Bansode's Buddhas displayed his early training at the hands of a Buddhist monk. Every line, every depiction was a work of love and devotion, the black and white works full of an inner radiance.



Haku Shah (1934–2019)

Haku Shah gave some of his most colourful, unusual works to us for inclusion in our exhibitions. Every year we would wait to see what new, amazing painting we would be able to cherish for a short period of time, until it was snapped up by an art lover at the exhibition.



John Fernandes (1951–2007)

John Fernandes women were so beautiful, so graceful, breathtaking. His "Kiran" in 2005 was truly a ray of light.



M. F. Husain (1915–2011)

A colleague got in touch with M. F. Husain and asked him to create a painting for our annual Rose Day. He immediately gave us this beautiful work which so aptly symbolizes the rose and the act of giving which is central to Rose Day.




Prafulla Dahanukar (1934–2014)

participated in every Colours of Life from 2006 onwards. She would invite us to her home in south Mumbai and ask us to choose from her many works. In 2013, we invited her to inaugurate our exhibition. She was her usual lively self so it was a shock to us when we heard she was no more.



Ramkumar (1924–2018)

A well known master, we approached Ramkumar with a lot of hesitation, but found him to be eminently approachable. Our Delhi branch collected his work from his home and couriered it to us. Looking back, I realize, we were very fortunate that the painting did not get damaged in transit. One of the many learnings we have gathered since 2005.



Suryaprakash (1940–2019)

I happened to be in Hyderabad in May and called up Suryaprakash to request his participation. He told me that he was busy with his solo show this year but would definitely give us a work next year. Barely a week later I heard he was no more. It was not to be.



Sunil Das (1939–2015)

When we called him, Sunil Das asked us to visit him at a guest house in Mumbai as he happened to be in the city. He was extremely hospitable and gave us his paper work casually rolled up in newspaper. As I carried it reverently down the stairs, I wondered at our luck.



Shyam Kanu Borthakur (1954–2014)

Shyam Kanu and his wife Jayita Borthakur were not just our supporters, they became our close friends thanks to their affectionate nature. It was a tragedy for us when Shyam was diagnosed with a deadly form of brain cancer. He soldiered on through difficult treatment, painting without slowing down, expressing his feelings through his art.



Tyeb Mehta (1925 –2009)

In the midst of the hysteria over the record breaking auction amount for his work, Mahishasur, we approached Tyeb Mehta with a great deal of trepidation. His wife came on the line and told us he was unwell, but that she would try to get him to make something for our show. We were amazed when he sent us a gorgeous charcoal on paper of a crow which today looks like it is wounded.



Yusuf Arakkal (1945–2016)

It was the Director of our Bangalore branch, Sarla Kohli who first made contact with Yusuf Arakkal. He created a beautiful painting of a girl holding a lamp in her hand, which appeared on the cover of a souvenir. He and his wife went on to give us many works.

At this time, we also remember Sarla Kohli as the person who came up with the title, "Colours of Life" which aptly describes this exhibition, which has become a labour of love for all connected with it.

We miss you all.
